- Improving stakeholder perception to improve key financial parameters (eg share price, borrowing power, insurability, market share) as well as intangibles such as brand value, corporate reputation
- Delivering operating and eco efficiency gains (resource efficiency, incorporating energy efficiency and waste reduction at source)
- Demonstrating assured legal compliance (eg via a robust EMS or IMS; environmental management plans and procedures)
- The need for robust evidence to underpin Governmental and EU policy
- The requirement for an authoritative response to avoid/mitigate potential enforcement action.

In response we provide:

- Risk-driven services: the modelling of risk dependencies; the delivery of business and financial benefits surrounding the EHS components/issues raised by transactions, major capital projects, property developments, portfolio holdings, supply chains; the risk assessment and management of contaminated land; carbon due diligence
- Compliance-driven services: eg compliance audits; Environmental Impact Statements; Environmental Management Plans; PPC/COMAH permitting, IMS/EMS development; carbon management systems
- Cost-driven services: Resource Efficiency (including waste minimisation and energy efficiency)
- Stakeholder-driven services: CSR; Sustainability/Sustainable Development; Governance support to meet reporting standards.
